Compostable (Organic) Waste – sorted before taken to waste disposal site  (NOT CURRENTLY ACCEPTED AT THIS LOCATION)	1	Organic material (e.g. food scraps, lawn and yard waste) in compostable bags (maximum 90 l or 76cm x 83 cm), up to 3 bags per load	\$3/load
	2	Organic material (e.g. food scraps, lawn and yard waste) - small pickup load (up to 0.3 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m of loose compostable waste or in more than 3 compostable bags if total volume is up to 0.3 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m)	\$5/load
	3	Organic material (e.g. food scraps, lawn and yard waste) - large pickup load (between 0.3 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m and 1.2 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m, either loose or in compostable bags)	\$10/load
	4	Organic material (e.g. food scraps, lawn and yard waste), either loose or in compostable bags, larger load than volume set out in item 3	\$14/m <sup>3</sup>
Brush and clean wood – sorted before taken to waste disposal site	5	Untreated wood; uncontaminated brush; trees	\$5/m <sup>3</sup>
Animal carcasses	6	Small animal (e.g. cat, dog, other small pet)	\$7/animal
	7	Large animal or part of animal (e.g. pig, deer, moose, bear, horse)	\$25/animal
Bulky item	8	Large item (e.g. mattress, box spring, wooden furniture, couch, recliner)	\$10/item
Construction or demolition material – sorted before taken to waste disposal site	9	Construction/demolition, grubbing/stripping, drywall and wood waste - small pickup load (up to 0.3 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m)	\$10/load
	10	Construction/demolition, grubbing/stripping, drywall and wood waste - large pickup load (between 0.3 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m and 1.2 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m) sorted before disposal at the waste disposal site	\$20/load
	11	Construction/demolition, grubbing/stripping, drywall and wood waste - larger load than volume set out in item 10	\$31/m <sup>3</sup>
Residual (household) waste – sorted before	12	Household waste - regular sized garbage bag (maximum 90 l or 76cm x 83 cm)	\$1/bag

Unsorted waste	16	More than one category of waste mixed together	\$50/m <sup>3</sup>
Metal waste sorted before taken to waste disposal site	17	White goods with refrigerant (e.g. refrigerator, freezer, air conditioner)	\$40/item
	18	Any other white goods (e.g. dishwasher, stove, washer, dryer)	\$15/item
	19	Scrap metal (e.g. clean tank or drum, scrap iron, bicycle, metal furniture) - small pickup load (up to 0.3 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m)	\$35/load
	20	Scrap metal (e.g. clean tank or drum, scrap iron, bicycle, metal furniture) – large pickup load (between 0.3 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m and 1.2 m x 1.8 m x 2.4 m)	\$70/load
	21	Scrap metal (e.g. clean tank or drum, scrap iron, bicycle, metal furniture)– larger load than volume set out in item 20	\$15/m <sup>3</sup>
	22	Vehicle (if all fluids are drained, tires are off rims and battery is removed)	\$150/item
	23	Vehicle (if all fluids are not drained, tires are on rims or battery is not removed)	\$300/item
Tires	24	Tires (if not separated from rim) with inner diameter of 99.06 mm. or less	\$5/item
	25	Tires (if not separated from rim) with inner diameter greater than 99.06 mm.	\$250/item
